

International Composition Competition

„From Romanticism to Contemporary”

3rd edition, 2009

Terms of the competition

1. The International Composition competition for young composers is organized by the National University of Music in Bucharest, through its Centre of Excellency for Scientific Research.
2. The competition is open for all young composers, aged up to 35 years old, no matter the nationality or country. The winners of the last editions of this competition cannot participate again.
3. There is no limit for the number of works to be submitted.
4. The works must not be previously published nor awarded in another composition competition.
5. The organizers reserve their rights for the first public representation and for the audio/video recording of the awarded works.

Awards:

6. The total value of the prizes is 15 000 lei.
7. The jury's decision will be announced at the final concert, which will take place in Bucharest, at Cantacuzino Palace at the end of May 2009.
8. The members of the jury are well known composers, selected from the academic European institutions.

The decisions of the jury are final !

Very important :

9. The work/score that is to be submitted must not have printed the name of the composer, but only a Motto.
10. The participants must submit 2 copies for each score and one copy in digital format, .pdf, .tiff etc.
11. The scores must be submitted in sealed, separate envelopes, marked with the same Motto. They must also contain the following:
 - a) Name and surname of the author,
 - b) Birth date and place of birth,

- c) Nationality,
- d) Postal address, phone number, fax number and e-mail address (yahoo messenger ID if applicable)
- e) Title of the work/works,
- f) CV with attached recent photo,
- g) Student proof, if applicable
- h) a copy of the receipt evidential of the signup fee
- i) A statement that will also contain the signature of the author:

“I agree that my work will be recorded and broadcasted on radio or TV if it will be awarded. I declare that this work that I submitted for the International Composition Competition “From Romanticism to Contemporary” was never published nor awarded in a different competition”

12. All documents must be sent to: National University of Music in Bucharest, 33rd Stirbei Voda Str., sector 1, Bucharest, Romania 010102.

We also accept email sign-up, if all requested documents will be scanned and then sent by mail.

13. The deadline for submission is May 14th 2009.

14. The final concert with the awards will be in Bucharest on May 30th 2009.

Application Fee :

15. 100 lei for each submitted work.
